VII. COMMENTS FACTS AND SPECIFIC ACHIEVEMENTS: During this period, Lt Edelblute has performed in an outstanding fashion. His great enthusiasm and initiative has been contagious to his students and has resulted in a passing rate of 100% on their upgrade evaluations with 75% of these receiving a Highly Qualified rating. His knowledge, tact and patience has resulted in such remarks as, "he is one of the best Instructors, I (the student) have had since I entered Titan II training." Lt Edelblute's system knowledge was recently demonstrated when a system malfunction required multiple reruns of a launch verification. Lt Edelblute's assistance in trouble-shooting the malfunction was instrumental in reaching an end item which resulted in a minimum of down time for the sortie. His knowledge was also well demonstrated while he was in Operational Readiness Training (ORT) at Vandenberg AFB. On his final evaluation on the Missile Procedures Trainer, he received a Highly Qualified score. On his upgrade check, he was rated Highly Qualified and selected for Instructor duty in the minimum of time. Lt Edelblute has demonstrated perfection in Emergency War Orders (EWO), attaining perfect scores on all recurring examinations. During a recent Operational Readiness Inspection, Lt Edelblute scored 100% on both exams. STRENGTHS: Lt Edelblute's system knowledge and confident manner make him an outstanding Instructor Deputy. His willingness to learn and to accept responsibilities will make him an outstanding Crew Commander. SUGGESTED ASSIGNMENTS: Lt Edelblute should be upgraded to Crew Commander as soon as eligible, followed by an assignment in a missile Staff position. SELF IMPROVEMENT EFFORTS: Lt Edelblute, being relatively new to the system, felt that a more comprehensive understanding of all missile and support function was needed. To further this goal, he has instituted an extensive and rigorous self-training program. OTHER COMMENTS: I highly recommend that he be tendered a Regular Commission.
